

## Focke-Wulf Fw.190A-4 Conversion from the Pacific Models Fw.190A-1/2/3

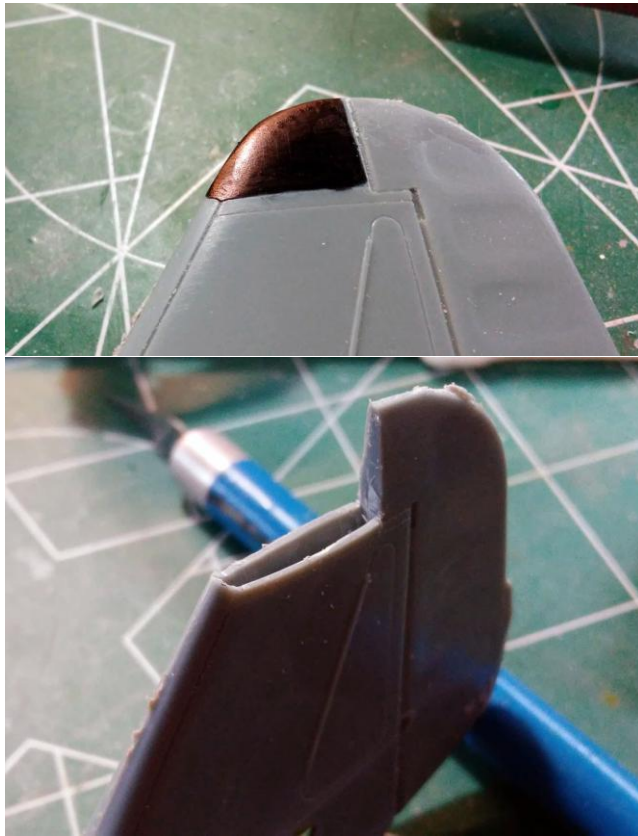
Only three small changes need to be made on the Fw.190A early versions, to achieve the very important A-4 version

- Vertical tail fin with antenna
- Right and Left engine grill exhausts had louvers in mid- and late- A-4 version. Early A-4 still had the opened grills

This conversion only needs an X-acto knife or modeling saw. **Follow the panel lines as a guide** to remove the extra plastic. Super glue (cyano-acrylate) is used for resin adhesion to plastic.

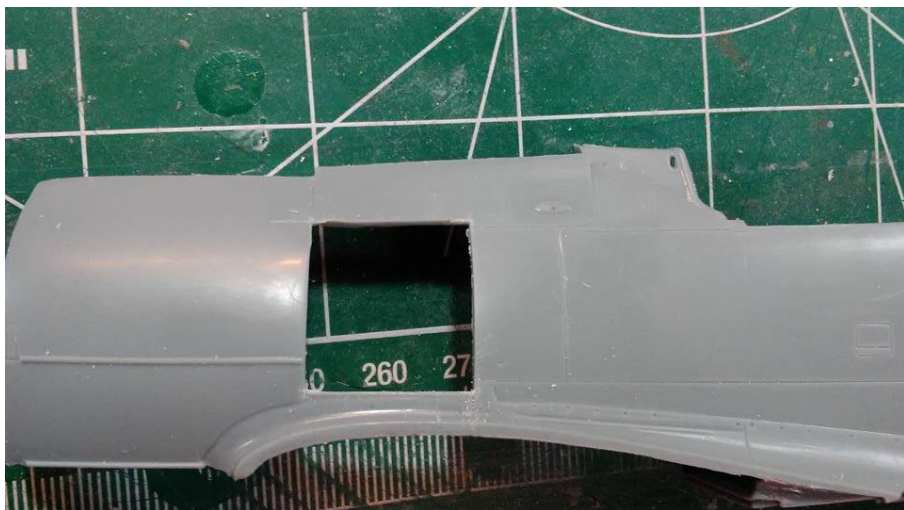
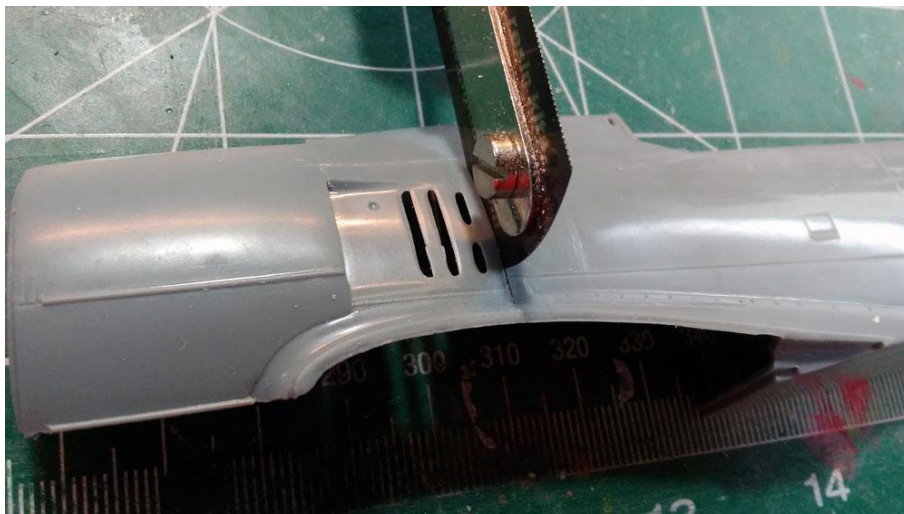
### Vertical tail fin with antenna:

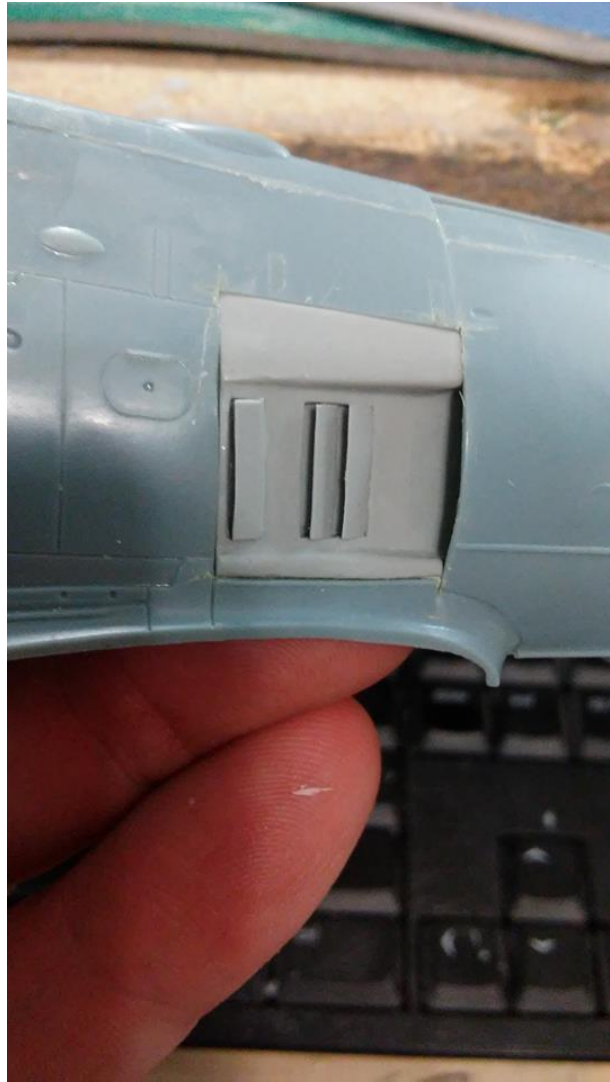
The “blackened area” is what is removed. Please be cautious as the forward part is angled and not straight. When this area is cleaned and slightly sanded, add the resin part



**Remove the engine grill exhaust:**

Please note that the forward portion is already molded open. You will need to remove the three sides, and slightly touch the upper front part





If these cuts are clean and properly sanded, it should fit tight and will not require extra putty
